



# Prevention Unit

*Iris House offers two programs to help HIV-positive women adopt risk-reducing behaviors:*

- ☞ **Las Divas Project** works with HIV-positive women to reduce or prevent HIV transmission and re-infection. This case management program provides:
  - ☞ One-on-one prevention counseling and support;
  - ☞ Assistance in accessing needed medical, psychological, & social services that affect your health and ability to change HIV-related risk taking behavior; and
  - ☞ Individual Level Interventions as well as weekly Group Level Interventions.
- ☞ **Community Service Program** is a collaborative response to the AIDS pandemic affecting Harlem communities. Through Iris House Peer Educators who have extensive knowledge of prevention-related topics, the program's primary goals are to:
  - ☞ Create a continuum of care for individuals who are HIV-positive; &
  - ☞ Provide culturally and linguistically appropriate prevention behavioral models for individuals at risk for HIV.

Peer Educators understand that supporting the wellness of another woman ultimately benefits the community. Through the outreach efforts of Iris House Peer Educators, thousands of people have received important prevention & health information.
