


Definition and Purpose

- Activism: Taking action on your political beliefs in a form of demonstrated action (protesting, etc.) in order to achieve change.
- Intersectionality:

A framework that explains how various social identities like race, gender, sexuality, and class, overlap and contribute to a specific type of oppression experienced by an individual.

Changing Hearts and Minds



- 7. Documente, Reporte, y Organize con la comunidad.




